

## **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

The Superintendent is responsible for developing administrative procedures regarding Christ The Redeemer (CTR) Catholic School Division's students' eligibility for participation in the graduation exercises. The criteria for receiving a diploma from CTR Catholic are different from the criteria for receiving a high school diploma from Alberta Education. The most notable difference is that CTR's graduation requires a service component and completion of religious education programming.

To receive a diploma from CTR, students must meet Alberta Education's high school diploma requirements and they must also meet other expectations that are unique to the well-rounded faith and liberal arts education the Board provides, including, but not limited to, the below.

This policy should be applied through Administrative Procedure STU #17 Graduation/Commencement Participation Requirements, which shall include, at a minimum, the following:

- Students must meet, or be on progress towards meeting, the credit requirements for graduation prescribed by the Minister of Education.
- Students must complete the requirements outlined in the Board's [Good Works Policy](#).
- Students shall meet minimum course load requirements.
- Students shall be required to pass one senior high Religious Studies Course for each year attending a CTR high school.
